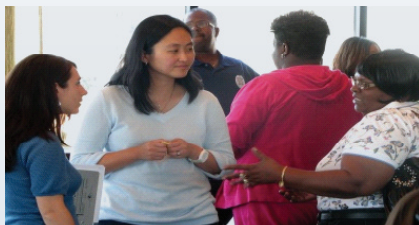

# GOALS FOR THE IBERVILLE TREMÈ TRANSFORMATION PLAN

## HOUSING

- More affordable housing options (homeownership and rental)
- One-for-one replacement of Iberville units (821)
- Mixed-income (2,400 total units)
- Meet needs of local population (elderly, disabled)
- Mixed-use
- Green building

## NEIGHBORHOOD

- Infrastructure and revitalization
  - Blight removal
  - Green space
  - Improved public spaces
- Expand access to amenities
  - Fresh foods
  - Neighborhood services
  - Business / job opportunities
- Support cultural assets

## PEOPLE

- Quality early childhood education
- Educated workforce
- Children are succeeding in school
- Employment and entrepreneurship opportunities
- Children and families are healthy
- Residents are safe in their community

## PROJECT GOALS

- Re-knit the Iberville development with the rest of the neighborhood
- Offer homeownership opportunities within the neighborhood
- Collaborate with City and RSD to reuse vacant publicly owned facilities (schools, LLT and HANO scattered sites)
- Target identified housing needs - homelessness and disabled through permanent supportive housing; elderly and nearing elderly group; smaller families
- Strategic reinvestment by focusing on commercial areas and corridors (Circle Foods, Canal St., Bienville St., Lafitte Greenway, etc...)
- Increase opportunities for early childhood education through the development of an Early Head Start Center and partnership with the Early Childhood and Family Learning Foundation
- Educational resource development
- Commitment to safe and secure neighborhoods
  - NOPD and HANO Police will develop a Neighborhood Watch Program
  - Incorporate physical design elements that support safety
- Increase access to healthcare for residents of the neighborhood
- Increase economic opportunities
- Support other major developments within the neighborhood such as the Lafitte Greenway and biomedical district
